

ACMHN additional Board Directors Expression of Interest (EOI)

Would you like to support the profession that supports the mental health of the community?

The Australian College of Mental Health Nurses (ACMHN) is seeking to augment its Board with the appointment of additional Board Directors to fill vacancies. We are looking for individuals who bring a background in one or more of the following: business development, legal expertise, and finance, with previous experience as a board director and the capability to support the organisation to achieve the objectives of the strategic plan and Constitution.

The ACMHN is the peak professional mental health nursing organisation in Australia and works to promote public confidence in and professional recognition of mental health nursing. The ACMHN Strategic Plan 2021-26 is available on request.

The ACMHN has been representing mental health nurses for over 40 years, with currently about 2600 members.

The ACMHN is an Incorporated Association and is bound by the South Australian Incorporations Act 1985. The National Office of the ACMHN is based in Canberra, with Board Directors from across the country.

The ACMHN is governed by a Board of Directors and the Constitution. The Board is comprised of six elected Directors including the College President, Vice-President and four additional Board Directors, one nominated Director who also undertakes the role of Chair of the Council of Branches, with an option to appoint up to two additional co-opted Directors. The Board is progressing to recruit additional Directors through this EOI. Depending on skills and requirements, such Directors may be any persons (including members or non-members but excluding people currently employed by the College).

The position of Board Director is an honorary position. Travel, accommodation, and out-of-pocket expenses associated with Board meetings will be covered or reimbursed, according to the ACMHN travel policy. Time commitments will be at least six hours each month, inclusive of monthly Board Meetings, Board Committees, members' forums and other governance related activities.
